

# The New Offsite Contribution Tool

Servant Keeper now allows users to enter contributions at an offsite, non-networked location, while other users are entering membership information at the main office or host location. Why is this important? Read on to find out.

With the ability to enter contributions into an offsite, non-networked computer while membership information is being entered on another machine simultaneously, Servant Keeper once again re-defines the possibilities of how a church membership program can be used. "This really opens up possibilities for smaller churches that have a volunteer treasurer who enters the contribution data at home," says Bill Newman, director of product development.

The new feature makes things easy for small churches to transfer offsite contributions into Servant Keeper without preventing the office administrator from entering membership information in the mean time.

## How does it work?

The process is pretty simple. You tell Servant Keeper which computer is the remote (ex. your home office) and which is the host (ex. your church office).

When you want to go home and enter contributions, you just check the data out of the host and take it to the remote site where you check it in to Servant Keeper. When you want to take contributions entered at the remote site to the office, just check the contributions out of the remote and then check them into the host.

The great thing is that while you're doing all of this, people can be still entering membership information at the host, without risk of having it over-written by the remote information.
